### **March 6 Application Deadline Approaching for 2009/2010 Two Rivers Art Project Public Exhibit**

*Exhibit is open to professional and amateur artists of all backgrounds*

Glenwood Springs, CO... The Two Rivers Art Project is looking for high quality sculptures for the 2009/2010 year-long public art display. The exhibit is open to professional and amateur artists of all backgrounds. Each artist may enter up to two works. There are no limitations on the dimensions. A selection committee will review all entries and choose up to ten pieces based on the originality of the piece, its durability and suitability for outdoors and safety for the public. The application deadline is March 6, 2009. Artisans, upon acceptance into the year long display, must be able to deliver their works by May 28/29, 2009 to the designated installation site. The application fee is \$30.

It has been a long time dream to create a strong public art program for the City of Glenwood Springs. The upcoming display will mark the second year-long Two Rivers Art Project exhibit. There are currently seven pieces on display. In May 2009, one piece will be selected as the "People's Choice Award", which will be donated to the City of Glenwood Springs for permanent display. The idea is that by the end of ten years, the City will have ten pieces of permanent, public art. The Two Rivers Art Project is a collaborative effort of the City of Glenwood Springs, the Glenwood Springs Center for the Arts and the Glenwood Springs Chamber Resort Association.
