THINGS TO KNOW

Beer Garden: The beer garden is contained in the fenced ball park area. Bring your ID if you plan on drinking alcohol. No outside alcohol or glass can be brought in or removed from the beer garden.

Emergency Services & Lost & Found: The Glenwood Springs Police Department is located at the gazebo on the northwest corner of the park.

Information & T-Shirt Booth: Available near the gazebo in the northwest corner of the park.

Parking: Vehicle parking around the park is limited, but there is plenty of FREE parking downtown and in the vicinity: Glenwood Springs High School, 1521 Grand Ave.; 9th & Cooper (parking structure); 8th & Cooper, CMC parking garage on 8th St. between Grand and Cooper. There are designated handicapped parking spaces at Sayre Park along North and South Hyland Park Dr.
